

440-444 W. WATER STREET

Known as one of the most outstanding hotels in Green Lake County, the American House Hotel was built in two stages. When fire destroyed the original building in 1885, the American House was built offering fine accommodations for area travelers. An 1891 article stated, "For \$2.00 per day, rooms offer steam heat, electric lights, and baths. All money, jewels, coats, valises (suitcases), and other valuables must be left in the office and checks received for them". From 1943-1962 the Hiestand family operated their popular footwear "Muk Luks" business here, which included a 1952 building addition. Retail space & apartments presently occupy the site.
