

511 W. WATER STREET

This elegant two-story building built prior to 1885, is included on the State Historical Register and boasts a strong Italianate design. The first owner of record was Christ Henning Jr. Sanborn maps from 1892 indicate a meat market/grocery business which continued for many years. In the mid-1990's, Dr. Duck's Soda & Phosphates and Ice Cream Parlor became a popular destination downtown. Current owners opened Pastimes in 2000, a store filled with folk art, antiques, and books. An expansion took place when the former barber shop at 513 was acquired and the stone wall was broke through opening up the two buildings.
