


528 W. WATER STREET

In 1885 the Mueller Brothers opened Princeton's first drug store at this location. Pharmaceutical services have been provided at this location for over 100 years. Listed on the National Historic Register, the building style is considered Commercial Vernacular, meaning it was designed based on local needs, availability of local building material, and reflects local traditions. In 1918, it became Breity's Drug Store and an ice cream parlor was added. Dr. Samuel Garro opened his first dental office on the second floor in the late 1940's. The Bentley family acquired the property in 1954 and continues the tradition of Bentley's Pharmacy.
