1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL.** Council President Roehl called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. In attendance were Alderpersons Kallas, Roehl, Garro, Bartol, and Ernest, Mayor Wielgosh, Administrator Neubauer, and Attorney Sondalle. Alderperson Kallenbach was absent at Roll Call, but arrived at approximately 6:02 PM.
2. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.** The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
3. **APPEARANCES FROM THE PUBLIC.** Nothing at this time.
4. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES :** Minutes from the 6/25/2019 Committee meeting Garro motioned to approve the 6/25/19, Council Meeting Minutes, seconded by Kallas. Carried 5-0.
5. **NEW BUSINESS**

 1. **Fire Association District meeting 9/4/2019 verbal update of meeting and 2020 operating budget attached** Administrator Neubauer gave an update: The main purpose of the meeting was the 2020 Fire Department Budget. The floor drain needs work in the Fire Station, the city will look at how to repair.
 2. **County Ambulance Study details attached per newspaper article of 9/12/2019** The County Board approved the ambulance Feasibility Study, which will be completed by the 1st of June 2020.
