July 8, 2020

Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Weckwerth. Open meeting laws met through posting and publication. Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve agenda. All ayes. Motion carried. Motion Rose Wick/Dan Kuglin to approve minutes of the June 10, 2020 meeting as posted. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner gives report. Scott Construction payment for Oxbow Trail sealcoat should be taken out of road construction fund. Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve treasurer's report and submit for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Maintenance Supervisor Report -- Chairman Weckwerth gives report. Daniel Boileau resigned. Second ditch cutting is almost complete. A third and possibly fourth ditch cutting will be done later in summer/fall. International needs to be ran. After Hours Lawn Care has been cutting lake access and town hall property. Pete Stoneberg will take care of Pleasant Valley Cemetery this year. Rock River will be picking up the waste oil. Lock Road is brand new and almost complete, with only shouldering left. Muskrat problem on Soda Road is being addressed. Wick's Landing and Lock Road also have muskrat problems. The Oshkosh Truck needs to be repaired. A list of town projects is being compiled.

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Kuharski Road Project Bids – Four contractors were contacted to give bids for the project, as well as being posted in local newspaper. Weckwerth reads the only bid proposal that was received from Kopplin & Kinas. The bid total from Kopplin & Kinas is \$16,275. Motion Allan Weckwerth/Dan Kuglin to approve the bid from Kopplin & Kinas for the Kuharski Road project. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Maintenance Supervisor Open Position – Job vacancy ad was placed in local papers and on website.

Chairman's Report and Correspondence – Weckwerth reads annual ambulance report from Berlin Ambulance Service. The Town of Princeton's responsibility for the budget shortfall was \$19,647.01. Hebbe Ditch Issue: Weckwerth reads letter from DNR. Past town minutes indicate this problem dates back to 1981. Water issue on Terrace is discussed. Weckwerth is meeting with the Green Lake Association on Friday to discuss problem. Town resident requests boat launch on Fox River Landing be put in immediately; however, water is too high.

Clerk's Report and Correspondence – Next election will be August 11, 2020.
