Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Weckwerth. Open meeting laws met through posting and publication. Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve agenda. All ayes. Motion carried. Motion Rose Wick/Dan Kuglin to approve minutes of the August 12, 2020 meeting as posted. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner gives report. SCBA Fund: Town funds will not to be added to 2021 budget, as a federal grant was awarded to provide funding. Fund transfers have all been made according to 2020 budget. Weckwerth reads email from Associated Appraisal in regard to Al Stott delinquent personal property. This will be further investigated. 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Wisconsin Elections Commission and Roads to Recovery Grant – Weckwerth reads email in regard to grant for ambulance funding. This is a demonstration plot. Cost is to be split by GLSD, Green Lake Association and Town. Signage will be placed explaining the project. Volunteers will be needed. Motion Al Weckwerth/Rose Wick to approve the project as proposed. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.
