### \*MINUTES

**August 12, 2020**

Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton, called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Weckwerth. Open meeting laws met through posting and publication. Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve agenda. All ayes. Motion carried. Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve minutes of the July 8, 2020 meeting as read. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner gives report. Discussion held. Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve treasurer's report and file for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Maintenance Supervisor Report – Pete Stoneberg completed work on Oshkosh, changing all four springs. Oil was changed in International. Steve Kutz will be asked to mow ditches. Al Weckwerth is cleaning around dump. "Escort" is being used to spray aside roads. Dan Kuglin thanks Al Weckwerth for all the work he's been doing without a maintenance supervisor.

Public Appearances – Nancy Cederholm appeared and requested a light on a pole be installed on the N. Parkway intersection. Nancy Cederholm inquired if board was looking into grants for run-off into Green Lake. Weckwerth states he spoke with Stephanie Prellwitz of the GL Association about the water. Mark Gleckman called about water sitting in his yard, asking if board would consider putting in a pipe to run the water from the road to the lake. Road by Swanson and Sandy Beach will not be paved if water problem isn't resolved. Three property owners were contacted to run a storm pipe to lake to resolve issue. None agreed. Lake is impaired due to low oxygen. If lake is impaired due to phosphorus, more grant money may be available. GLSD and GL Association are knowledgeable about grant writing for the lake. Small town right of way on Terrace was discussed.

Payment of Claims – Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to pay claims as submitted. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

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Proposed Agricultural Enterprise Area – Todd Morris appears from Green Lake County Land Conservation. Eleven landowners have signed up in support of this program so far. Morris is asking if town board would be interested in the program. A tax break (approximately \$5 per acre) is given to property owners and when signing up for it, stating they will use good land practices. Motion Al Weckwerth/Dan Kuglin to support AEA in the Town of Princeton. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Drainage issue on Old Green Lake Road: Todd Morris is working with David Bogucke to set up drainage. Pricing is \$8 per foot, 200 feet, totaling \$1600. County pays part of this, inquiring if town will pay some. Unsure at this point who will be doing the work.

2020 Roadwork Update – South Lakeshore Drive is complete. Concrete truck spilled hydraulic oil on road while pouring basement at N4803 S. Lakeshore Drive. Northeast Asphalt has to return to fix some driveways that are too steep.

Mandatory Election Machine Upgrade – Letter from Liz Otto, County Clerk was read. Cost to Town will be \$6600. The County will pay \$1178. Motion by Weckwerth/Kuglin to approve the purchase of voting machine and to pay for it within the first year. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Maintenance Position – No update

Chairman's Report and Correspondence – No update on Kuharski Rd. Wicks Landing boat launch and Fox River Drive boat launch are in the process of being upgraded. New concrete planks are being poured soon, waiting on gravel. Old ditch side mower was taken apart and it is in "in time" but it hasn't been used yet. No extra parts are available for this mower, and it is not worth spending money on to repair further. It will be listed on consignment auction website this fall.

Clerk's Report and Correspondence – August 11, 2020 Election had 425 voters.

Next Meeting Date – Fire budget meeting will be August 19, 2020 at 7:00 pm. Fire District Meeting will be September 2 at 7:00 pm and next regular meeting date will be September 9, 2020 at 7:00 pm

Adjourn – Motion by Kuglin/Wick to adjourn. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.
