Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton, called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Weckwerth. Open meeting laws met through posting and publication. Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve agenda. All ayes. Motion carried. Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve minutes of the March 11, 2020 meeting as read. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner is absent. Weckwerth discusses report. Motion Rose Wick/Dan Kuglin to approve treasurer's report and file for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Maintenance Supervisor Report – Dan Boileau is present. Roads needed to be salted in a few spots this morning. Waiting for pot-fill material. International tailgate is being repaired. Kuglin asks for holes to be filled with gravel, by Reilly's, while awaiting fill. Salt shed inspection is complete. Shed passed inspection. Some repairs may need to be made over summer.

Public Appearances – Rose Wick questioned what action town was taking with garbage service and recycling. No action will be taken.

Payment of Claims – Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to pay claims as submitted. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

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2020 Roadwork Projects – Weckwerth reads 2020 Roadwork Proposals. Proposals are on file. Discussion held. Motion Allan Weckwerth/Dan Kuglin to approve the two proposed work specs for summer roadwork as read. Ad for bids will be placed in paper. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Tractor Sale Update – White tractor was sold. Town received \$6,075. Taxes and fee were paid by buyer to the auction website that tractor was posted on.

Proposed Town Disaster Resolution Due to Covid-19 Pandemic – Weckwerth reads proposed resolution. Discussion held. Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to adopt Resolution 01-2020. Roll Call: Chairman Weckwerth, yes; Supervisor Kuglin, yes; Supervisor Wick, yes. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Chairman's Report and Correspondence – Annual Meeting set for Tuesday, April 21, 2020 will be postponed until the regular monthly meeting on May 13, 2020. Weckwerth goes over history of roadwork in the town. Sealcoat needs are discussed. Motion Kuglin/Weckwerth to hire Scott Construction for sealcoating of Oxbow Trail, using hot oil and peastone. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Culverts on end of Old Green Lake Road have issues. There are a total of six culverts. All six are half full of dirt. Weckwerth proposes to change one and study the area to see what drainage in that area needs. Weckwerth contacted Green Lake County Land Conservation. New culvert on South Lake Shore Drive will be installed. Culvert in front of Richter's will be changed on Old Green Lake Road, due to it being rusted out.

Clerk's Report and Correspondence – April 7, 2020 election had 500 voters, 316 of those voters were absentee. Election costs are discussed.

Next Meeting Date – The Annual Meeting and the next Regular Town of Princeton Board meeting to be held on May 13, 2020 at 7:00 pm.

Adjourn – Motion by Kuglin/Wick to adjourn at 8:56 pm. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.
