PRINCETON FIRE & RESCUE DISTRICT MINUTES

June 4, 2025

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Weckwerth at 7 PM. Members present were, TOP, Weckwerth, Kuglin, TOM Raddatz, Breiling, Steffes, TSTM- Karlovich, Beck, Mashuda, COP Ernest. The quorum was met as was the certification of open meeting laws. Motion to approve agenda, Kuglin, 2nd Beck, carried. Motion to approve March 5, 2025 minutes, Raddatz, 2nd Kuglin, carried.

Elections, Chairman, motion by Kuglin for Weckwerth to continue, 2nd Ernest, carried, Vice Chairman, Motion by Kuglin for Raddatz to continue, 2nd, Karlovich, carried, Secretary/treasurer, motion by Raddatz for Becky Kuglin to continue, 2nd by Karlovich, carried.

Treasurer- TOP paid their operating costs early, so the balance is more than normal at this point. Payroll wasn't included on the report, M/A 1680.00, meeting, 3820.00 payroll, 3157.00 and billed service 6840.00, total of 15497.00. Motion by Kuglin to approve report, 2nd Beck, carried.

Maintenance- Nothing major, did a repair on a hose reel on the UTV

Fire inspector- Prill is still helping out, a couple of the younger members are interested in learning how to do this. They are working on the first half, there is on place with the city that has some issues to be dealt with. It was brought up that all 4 municipalities signed and passed a resolution for some places only needing one inspection a year instead of 2.

Chief's- Pulvermacher said that the roster is staying the same. They did a number of controlled burns this spring, usually get a donation for doing it. During one burn, they did have a tree come down on a ff, transported by ambulance, but no major injuries. Pulvermacher is trying to the Maintenance of Effort paperwork done and sent to each municipality.

Purchasing The fire department used their money to purchase airbags for lifting. They also want to buy a battery operated cutter for extrication(using FD funds). They will be keeping the "attached" jaws also, Raddatz said it would be foolish to get rid of it. DNR purchasing were made also.

Update Oshkosh fund, from Betsy, she spoke with Carlene from there, the name will be changed to go under the District instead of the fire department. There needs to be 2 people for contacts, with one person as the main contact. Weckwerth thinks it should be named by position, not by a person. Kuglin stated that it should be the Chairman and vice chairman. Motion made by Kuglin to have the Chairman and Vice chairman as contacts/ signer for the Oshkosh fund, 2nd Ernest, carried. B. Kuglin was told to work with Roehl to get an email established for District business. Next meeting 9/3/2025 Motion to adjourn Kuglin, 2nd Karlovich, carried
