The St. John the Baptist Catholic Church congregation set the cornerstone for the new church in 1887. 250,000 bricks were transported on the Fox River from a Portage brick works for the construction of the Church. The beautiful structure was built for about \$14,000 and provided worship services for 1282 members. Hosting several ornate features, the beautiful sculptured Stations of the Cross have hung in the church since 1914. Stained glass windows depicting the Saints were added in the 1930's. Known for hosting the "Oldest Church Picnic in Wisconsin", this annual event is held every August on the church grounds.
