

# ORDINANCE NO. 2025-01

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance 49-17 entitled "Special assessment for delinquent utility bills and City services".

The Common Council of the City of Princeton in session duly begun on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2025 does ordain as follows:


SECTION 1: City of Princeton Ordinance 49-17 entitled "Special assessment for delinquent utility bills and City services" is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 49-17 Special Assessment for delinquent utility bills and City services.


- (E) If the amount due to City utilities for services listed in Subsection C(5) is not paid when due, the City utilities shall send a notice of the delinquent bill to the customer and to the property owner pursuant to Ch. PSC 113, Wis. Adm. Code. If the bill is still delinquent by the month of October of the billing year, the City utilities shall send a notice of the delinquent bill to the customer and the property owner by standard mail, and the City may collect arrears for these services, inclusive of electrical services, under the procedures set forth in Wis. Stats. §66.0809(3). Additionally, the City may collect arrears for the services listed in Subsection C(5) from property owners of rental units as set forth in Wis Stats. §66.0809.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication.
