Town of Berlin had 246 voters.

Town of Brooklyn had 625 voters. Ran out of ballots in 2 districts.

Town of Green Lake had 229 voters. Only write ins not on the tape should be on the tally sheet.

Town of Kingston had 110 voters.

Town of Mackford had 84 voters. Added write ins and undervotes together.

Town of Manchester had 119 voters. Added write in and undervotes together.

Town of Marquette had 77 voters.

Town of Princeton had 355 voters.

Town of St. Marie had 97 voters.

Town of Seneca had 86 voters. Only write-ins not on the tape should be on the tally sheet.

City of Berlin had 709 voters.

City of Green Lake had 320 voters. Only write-ins not on the tape should be on the tally sheet.

City of Princeton had 218 voters. Totals off by two voters by ward. Wrong ballots issued – overall total correct.
