APPROVAL OF 04/07/2025 CANVASS BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Motion/second (Sonnleitner/Otto) to approve the 04/07/2025 Canvass Board meeting minutes with one correction. Motion carried with no negative vote.

The tally sheets and poll lists were inspected for each municipality in Green Lake County.

Town of Berlin had 305 voters.

Town of Brooklyn had 662 voters. They couldn't find two ballots at the end of the night. They found them the following day in the machine. They reconvened the Friday after the election.

Town of Green Lake had 401 voters.

Town of Kingston had 158 voters.

Town of Mackford had 156 voters.

Town of Manchester had 209 voters.

Town of Marquette had 157 voters.

Town of Princeton had 486 voters.

Town of St. Marie had 123 voters.

Town of Seneca had 98 voters.

Village of Kingston had 95 voters.

Village of Marquette had 47 voters.

City of Berlin had 863 voters. There was a tie for District 17. The board of canvassers did a hand draw. Robert Grim won. City of Berlin also had 1 provisional ballot that never got turned in.

City of Green Lake had 337 voters.

City of Markesan had 333 voters.

City of Princeton had 317 voters. They had to pull a ballot as the voter did not sign the poll book.

Meeting adjourned at 10:10 AM.
