

## 432 W. WATER STREET

Over the years, this quaint building has hosted a number of retail businesses. However for 35 years, it was home to the Princeton Public Library. In 1948, Mrs. Hugo Stern donated the property to the City in memory of her late husband. As books were carried across the street from the second story of the Flatiron building, a Library with first floor access was welcomed by the patrons. The Library continued at this location through the mid 1980's. In 2007, keeping with her family's Princeton heritage, Cindy Gossage (granddaughter of John & Lillian Hotmar of Hotmar's Hardware Store) ran Baubles Jewelry for 10 years.
