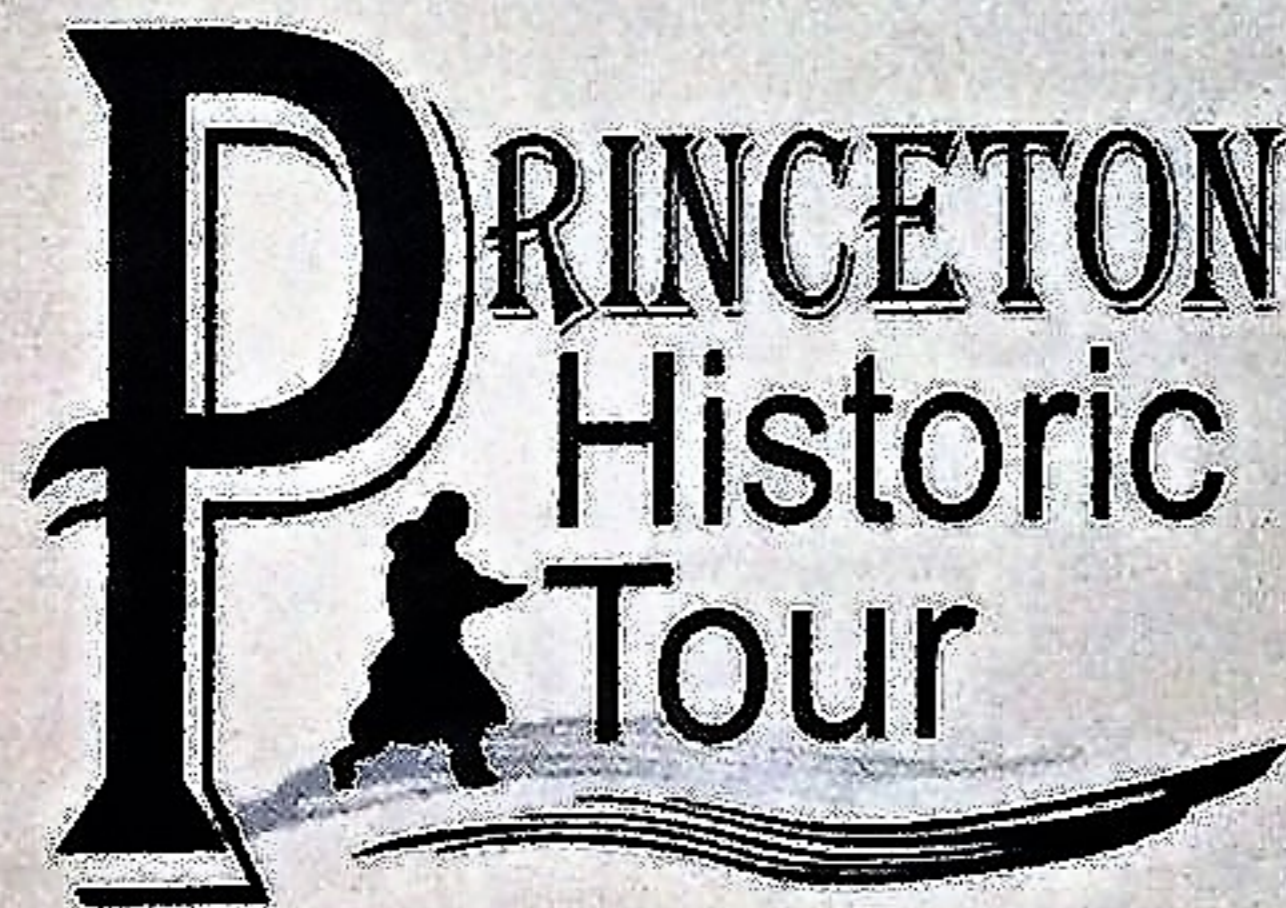


435 W. WATER STREET

Welcoming bowlers to Princeton since 1943, this 4 lane bowling center is a rarity in today's market. While the original building burned down in the 1880's, it was rebuilt as a garage and later repurposed into a bowling alley by WWI Veteran Isaac J. Craite. Local youth could be found here setting pins by hand until 1957 when Leonard Anderson invested over \$20,000 to install the Brunswick pinsetters that are still in use to this day. In 2014, this bowling center was featured in the documentary "Pints and Pins", which highlighted historic bowling alleys throughout the state.
