

## 538 W. WATER STREET

Built in 1884, the original structure was referred to as a “double building”, and is included in the State Historical Registry in spite of significant renovation. Once a prominent downtown hotel, other tenants included Wilsey Furniture Store and several taverns. In the 1960’s the building was significantly altered when the trend for store fronts included a slip cover of aluminum and large plate glass windows. Skogmos, a popular mid-west clothing and retail store occupied the property during this time. The building was renovated to restore several original historic features and occupied as Once in a Blue Moon Restaurant.
