The Megow family name has long been associated with this downtown location. The original building built in the mid 1800's, was the two story home and business of Herman E. Megow. A third story, featuring an ornate roofline ironworks railing, was later added for Herman's studio and gallery. Herman E. Megow was known throughout the area as a fine photographer and as Judge Megow. Herman also opened the first barbershop, conducted its first cigar store, and ran a cranberry brokerage business. In 1916, Herman A. Megow (son) opened a meat market featuring quality products that were shipped all over the U.S. Since 1994, the site has been home to the picturesque Megow Park.
