



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Princeton Riverwalk

RE: Downtown Boardwalk/Development Project presentation

Attached please find a conceptual diagram which was presented by Derek Kavanaugh. It is for the 600 block of Water Street and connects with Megow Park.

The project does cross the private property of the corner building (occupied as Blackbaye Boutique) which if this was the concept we would follow will require an easement from the owner of that property. Also, it was mentioned that regulations are sometimes lesser for municipalities however it was confirmed with our DNR representative that the regulations are the same for all.

The Boardwalk is over the rip rap and has three bump-outs which are fishing platforms. If the Council would like to discuss some additional options for riverbank improvements, we can have additional discussion with the DNR as there are potential funding sources we can look into.

As the diagram was just brought in late Wednesday afternoon, I have not heard back on the funding opportunities but may have more information to provide at the meeting.
