When the Bandstand was built, regular evening concerts were held in the City Park and Princeton had many local bands that played there. In 1974 the Princeton Flea Market started, and the bottom part of the Bandstand was converted into a “Food Booth” that local non-profit groups use to serve food to the patrons of the Flea Market. The Food Booth was dedicated to Raymond “Duke” Schlaefer after he died, in honor of his volunteerism and community service. At one point, the upper story had been removed, however when the Bandstand was remodeled in 2012, the upper level was replaced.
