May 13, 2020

Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton, called to order after the Annual Meeting at 7:08 PM by Chairman Weckwerth. Open meeting laws met through posting and publication. Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve agenda. All ayes. Motion carried. Motion Rose Wick/Dan Kuglin to approve minutes of the April 13, 2020 meeting as read. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner gives report. Discussion held. Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve treasurer's report and submit for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Attorney Sondalle is trying to locate property owner Stott for delinquent personal property at 4369 Wick's Landing Rd. Service is being attempted but unsuccessful. No adjusted interest was given by US Bank this month.

Maintenance Supervisor Report -- Daniel Boileau gives monthly report. Discussed springs on Oshkosh truck and cost, work will be done in-house at \$1,100 per side. International motor rebuild will be done on Friday. Total cost is \$5,350. There will also be a towing bill from Kopplin & Kinas. Sandy Beach is in the process of being fixed. DNR checklist needs to be followed. No permit is needed. Weckwerth is working with Todd Morris from Green Lake County Land Conservation regarding Sandy Beach. Losinski Road culverts were discussed.

Motion by Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to approve bid by Northeast Asphalt for South Lakeshore Drive for \$87,067. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Bids are signed.

Sealcote Update -- Scott's Construction sent a bid for sealcoating Oxbow Trail for \$39,659.68 for 2.24 miles of road, as approved at the April 13, 2020 meeting. This will come out of the road construction fund.

Salaries of non-elected personnel: Maintenance supervisor receives \$21.50 an hour. Position is hourly pay with no benefits, week's vacation after the first year and a vacation day added for each year of service. No adjustment will be made. The part time labor rate is currently \$13 per hour. Motion Weckwerth/Kuglin to raise part time labor rate to \$15 per hour. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Current CDL wage is \$15 per

hour. Motion Weckwerth/Kuglin to raise CDL pay to \$17 per hour. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. The St. John Lutheran Men's Club will continue to work the recycling service center every first and third Saturday. Motion to keep the \$100 per month payment/donation. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Current election worker hourly rate is \$11.00 per hour. Chief Election Inspector hourly rate is currently at \$12/hr. Motion by Weckwerth/Kuglin to raise chief inspector hourly pay to \$15 and election worker pay to \$13/hr. Roll Call: Chairman Weckwerth: Yes. Supervisor Kuglin: Yes. Supervisor Wick: Abstain. All ayes. None opposed. One abstained. Motion carried.

Designation of Bank Depository – Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to keep official bank depository as US Bank. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Designation of Official Newspaper – Motion Dan Kuglin/Rose Wick to designate the official paper as Berlin Journal Newspapers (Princeton Times Republic). All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Recycling Discussion -- Rose Wick brings up unauthorized dumping of things in recycling dumpsters. Discussion. No action taken.

Building Inspectors -- Mike Jankowski, builder, requests that the town hire a building inspector for projects in the township. Erik Arneveit, Design Specialty Builders, also is in agreement. Dick Severson makes a statement. Ben Moderow, a builder and Town of Green Lake Chairman, makes a statement. Weckwerth reads proposal sent by Grand Valley Inspections, Susan Leahy, sent in September of 2019. Motion by Dan Kuglin/Allan Weckwerth to place on agenda for June meeting to adopt an ordinance for building inspections Roll Call: Chairman Weckwerth: Yes. Supervisor Kuglin: Yes. Supervisor Wick: Abstain. This matter will be tabled until the June meeting.

Chairman's Report and Correspondence – Chairman Weckwerth has been in contact with Todd Morris from Green Lake County Land Conservation and the DNR in regard to the culverts on the east end of Old Green Lake Road.

Clerk's Report and Correspondence – Recycling Report has been submitted. Twenty-six golf cart registration stickers have been issued thus far.
