Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton, called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Weckwerth. Open meeting laws met through posting and publication. Motion Kuglin/Weckwerth to approve agenda. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Motion Kuglin/Weckwerth to approve minutes of the January 8, 2020 of the regular meeting as published. All ayes. None opposed Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner gives report. Motion Kuglin/Weckwerth to approve treasurer's report and file for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Maintenance Supervisor Report – Pete Stoneberg, Interim Maintenance Supervisor, gives report. Seven snowstorms this month. Three broken hoses and one freeze up on plow trucks. Two loads of sand and two loads of salt were delivered. New road signs are out. New tires were put on Ford.
