The tally sheets and poll lists were inspected for each municipality in Green Lake County.

Town of Berlin had 477 voters.

Town of Brooklyn had 819 total voters. They had one provisional ballot returned. The tapes were adjusted to reflect that total.

Town of Green Lake had 466 total voters. They ran out of Markesan School District ballots and had to use paper. Tapes were changed to reflect the total.

Town of Kingston had 180 total voters.

Town of Mackford had 163 total voters.

Town of Manchester had 234 total voters.

Town of Marquette had 192 total voters. They ran out of Markesan School District ballots and had to use paper. Tapes were changed to reflect the total.

Town of Princeton had 619 total voters.

Town of St. Marie had 142 total voters.

Town of Seneca had 145 total voters.

Village of Kingston had 115 total voters.

Village of Marquette had 63 total voters.

City of Berlin had 1318 total voters.

City of Green Lake had 388 total voters. They ran out of ballots in Ward three and had to

use paper. Those paper ballots were then used through the machine. Ultimately, they had to pull two ballots due to the number of voters and number of ballots in the machine not matching.

City of Markesan had 359 total voters.

City of Princeton had 344 total voters.
