

PRINCETON CITY CEMETERY

On April 2, 1907 a vote was taken by the people of the City of Princeton on whether to take over the Cemetery from the Cemetery Association. Of the 311 ballots cast, 175 were in favor, and 136 votes were against it. The Original Plat of the Cemetery is laid out in the shape of a cloverleaf. In July 1914, the 3rd Addition was added when 4 acres were purchased for \$1100, and since that time the City has added a 4th and 5th Addition. Early gravesites date back to the 1700's along with several from the 1800's. Many Veterans from the War of 1812, Civil War. WWI & WWII, Korean & Vietnam Wars are laid to rest in the Cemetery.
