October 9, 2019

Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton, called to order. Open meeting laws met through posting and publication. Motion Kuglin/Otto to approve agenda. All ayes. Motion carried. Motion Kuglin/Otto to approve minutes of the September 11, 2019 meeting as posted. All ayes. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner gives report. Motion Kuglin/Otto to submit report for audit. All ayes. Motion carried.

Maintenance Supervisor Report – Gary Anderson gives report. International is put back together. Oshkosh is in process of repair. Speed limit (25 mph) signs are up on Orchard Ave. Culvert work patched on Lazy L Road. Pothole filling on Orchard Avenue is done. Cutting of the ditches is in progress. Swamp Rd. was fixed and repaved.

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2020 Census update and community partnership – Dawn Miller from Census Bureau appears and explains the census. Census begins on April 1, 2020. Chairman Weckwerth discusses impact census has on town.

Election Security Sub grant Program and Memorandum of Understanding – Motion Weckwerth/Kuglin to participate in the Wisconsin Elections Commission Sub grant. Grant provides election security training, secure computer and IT service.

Terrace Golf Cart Ordinance – Weckwerth reads updated proposed golf cart ordinance. Motion Kuglin/Otto to enact ordinance as read. Roll Call Vote: Chairman Weckwerth: Yes; Supervisor Kuglin: Yes; Supervisor Otto: Yes. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

2020 Road project applications – Weckwerth explains Local Road Improvement Program, 50-50 and 90-10 programs. Application will be completed for Kuharski Road for the 50-50 project and an application will be completed for Cradle Road for the 90-10 program. Possible future road projects: First, Second, Nelson Road and South Lakeshore totaling .66 miles for an approximate cost of \$94,000, and South Lakeshore Drive and Swanson's totaling 1.34 miles for approximate cost \$190,000 discussed.

Chairman's Report and Correspondence – Dilapidated buildings discussed. Certified road mileage is 37.54 miles in Town. Weckwerth reads Princeton Lock and Dam Property Closure Notice. Project is scheduled to begin mid October 2019 with a tentative completion date of November of 2020. Garbage situation will be tabled until a future hearing.

Clerk's Report and Correspondence – New Edge election machine will need to be purchased in 2022.

Next Meeting Date – Green Lake County Unit WTA meeting is 10/17/18 at 7:00 at Lakeview hosted by the Town of Green Lake. Special 2019 proposed budget meeting on November 13, 2019 at 7:00 pm, with the regular monthly meeting to be held immediately after.
